1. Student must demonstrate a strong interest in joining the oil and natural gas midstream industry.
2. Students must currently be enrolled as a full time student (at least 12 credit hours) at a partner school and at least in the second year of a two-year or four-year undergraduate degree program with a concentration in engineering or petroleum technology.
3. Student must possess a grade point average of 2.8 or greater on a 4.0 scale. Proof or verification of GPA may be requested by the Scholarship Committee.
4. Student must be a US Citizen.
5. Student cannot be a relative of an ABGPA Scholarship Committee member.

Scholarship applications for the 2018 school year must be emailed to scholarships@abgpa.org.

The Deadline for application submittal is July 1, 2018.

The Appalachian Basin GPA Midstream Association Scholarship Committee will review the applications and award August 1, 2018. Please note that verification of submitted Grade Point Average (GPA) may be requested from selected applicants.
